Teaching and Leadership Innovation Fund (TLIF) – round 1 provision

As you may know the Teaching and Leadership Innovation Fund (TLIF) is a 3-year investment worth £75 million, which will support professional development for teachers and school leaders in the areas and schools in England that need it most. There are currently [8 TLIF providers](#) across England who are offering a variety of programmes aiming to increase existing teachers' skills, confidence and knowledge in a range of areas including leadership, improving teaching, retention and career progression, managing challenging pupil behaviour, science, technology, engineering, mathematics and phonics.



The TSC has been asked by the DfE Regional Delivery Division (RDD) to help them to raise awareness of the TLIF provision and help to ensure it reaches the schools that most need it. Please pass this information on to colleagues who you feel may find it helpful
