#### Strategic School Improvement Fund Round 2 Update

A list of schools in the EMSYH region, that meet the eligibility criteria set out in guidance for Round 2 of the Strategic School Improvement Fund ,has been sent to representatives who sit on the Sub Regional Improvement Boards (SRIBs)/Partnership meetings. The list is not being published, but rather shared with sub-regional improvement boards on a privileged basis, for sharing with organisations considering applying to the fund, including Teaching Schools. SRIB members have been asked not to share the list more widely than that and that it is not published or shared in an uncontrolled manner. If you are considering applying for the fund please contact your SRIB representative .
