The Programme

This 2 ½ day programme is aimed at recently qualified teachers (2-4 years) who are secure in their teaching practice and are ready to explore excellence in teaching and a first step into leading others.

The programme explores the key skills and competencies required to thrive in the classroom and start to develop into a leadership role.

The programme has been developed by the East Midlands Teaching School Alliance (EMTSA), which is a network of all Teaching Schools across the East Midlands; and is heavily subsidised by the National College for Teaching & Leadership.

Coaching

A key element of this programme is the support of a coach from within your own school. Coaches need to attend a CPD element of this programme. You will need to identify this coach and meet with them in advance of day 1 of the programme. The coach should be:

- An existing middle or senior leader
- Able to have at least 4 coaching conversations between November 2017 and March 2018
- Be prepared to put aside time to help improve your practice
- Be available to be released for half a day training and programme briefing
