GDPR Compliance for this weekly update email



As you will be aware the GDPR regulations come into force from **Friday 25th May**. We will continue to send you this update and occasional emails under the legal basis of 'Legitimate Interest' because this is the 'official' update from the TSC in the region and is being sent to Teaching Schools and System Leaders. There is no need for you to 'opt-in' but you can of course request to be removed from the mailing list at any time by simply replying to an email from us.

The data we hold is your name, school/organisation, TSA (where applicable) and email address. This is held securely and not shared beyond the TSC regional infrastructure (TSC Reps, Local Leads and the Business Support Partner SDSA).

For anyone on the mailing list that has signed up with a personal email address we will ask you separately to confirm you are happy to continue receiving the weekly update to that address.

For Information NLG Designation Round Deferred

The DfE's strategy for school improvement is being reviewed to ensure that there is a financially sustainable network of the best agents of school improvement that has the biggest impact on pupil outcomes and which reaches all the schools that need such support. As part of this, they are assessing the targeting of NLG designations across the country and how best to maintain NLG coverage of support for those that need it. The next designation round, which would have taken place in this current school year, is therefore being deferred. Through the NLG regional advocate role, our regional Stronger Governance Champion and the team of Area Coordinators, the DfE are continuing to focus on ensuring that all NLGs are deployed in the schools with the greatest need.
